

The data in this chart are from the same calendar year and provide an overview of the relative frequency of child-welfare safety decisions. Children are counted once at each level of involvement (unduplicated counts). This is not a cohort analysis. A child counted at one level of child-welfare involvement (e.g., Entries) is not necessarily counted at the preceding level (e.g., Substantiations). A child's entry to foster care in early 2023-counted in Jan-Dec 2023 Entriesmight be based on a 2022 substantiation, not included in Jan-Dec 2023 Substantiations.

Changes in Education and Legal/Law Enforcement are highlighted. Public health restrictions associated with COVID-19 began approximately March 2020.


Allegations by Disposition Type


Child Maltreatment Substantiations

Incidence per 1,000 Children, Jan-Dec 2023




Child Maltreatment Substantiations by Age

• Jan-Dec 2019 vs • Jan-Dec 2023




Recurrence of Maltreatment

Substantiated Allegation during 12-month Period Interval: Oct-Sep




Entries to Foster Care
