# Berkeley Social Welfare OMP: Enhances knowledge of TAY Outcomes

- Outcomes Monitoring Platform will add to the CCWIP website measures of well-being for TAY currently and formerly in foster care
  - Postsecondary education, employment, use of public benefits (CalWorks, CalFRESH, SSI), placement stability, discharge outcomes, justice system involvement, parenting, etc.
- CCWIP intends to work with a wide range of interested parties to identify the most policy- and practice-relevant outcomes to post on the CCWIP website
